## **INTRODUCTION**

This online course -*Understanding and Working with Complex Traumatic Dissociation* - is introductory and intended to provide a foundation in essential (but not sufficient) concepts. Further training along with appropriate supervision is needed in order to develop your practice for working therapeutically with clients who experience complex trauma including those who may have a dissociative identity. The selected reading (see p7) can also help you to develop your knowledge and understanding. The course consists of four modules, each made up of video presentations from leading UK professionals and experts-by-experiences together with slides, integral experiential exercises, handouts and further resources to support your learning. All the non-video material you need to complete the course is contained in this booklet, together with details of how to access the video presentations.
